

Our Reponsibility

Taking responsibility, driving change:

At Majestic, we're passionate about making a positive impact – on the planet and within the communities we proudly serve.

Environmental sustainability: We're on a mission to reduce our carbon footprint and champion sustainable practices across our operations:

Renewable energy: 99.72% of our operations are powered by renewable electricity, supported by Renewable Electricity Guarantees of Origin (REGO).

Greener fleet: We're committed to cutting air pollution and CO2 emissions and have introduced hybrid options alongside a CO2 cap of 129g/km for our company cars - replacing many of our existing diesel vans with electric vehicles, and aiming for all future additions to the van fleet being electric by 2030.

Energy efficiency: All new stores since 2020 utilise LED lighting and we'll continue replacing halogen lights with energy efficient sources in all future store upgrades.

For colleagues and customers we offer EV charging points at all new stores opened since the summer of 2021, and at our Watford support centre. We'll continue this roll-out as we develop our store estate.



Sustainable wine practices: As members of the Sustainable Wine Roundtable (SWR) since 2024, we collaborate globally to tackle industry challenges like packaging innovation, low-carbon logistics and eco-friendly vineyard management.

We are certified by the Soil Association to import and distribute organic wine.



Recycling: We recycle all pallets across our transport and supply chain networks and recycle all the shrink wrap we use to keep pallets secure. We also divert 100% of our recyclable waste and 90% of our general waste away from landfill.

Our commitment also includes creative initiatives like our cork recycling scheme, which has repurposed over four tonnes of cork in partnership with The Eden Project.



Social responsibility:

We believe in fostering inclusivity and giving back to society:

Charity: Becoming a key part of the communities we operate in is at the heart of the Majestic DNA. Over the years Majestic has raised more than £1 million for various charities through the incredible support of our colleagues, customers and suppliers. Through our previous approach to work with a national Charity of the Year, we raised over £125,000 for The Brain Tumour Charity in 2021, and in 2022 we donated more than £200,000 to Alzheimer's Society.



Diversity, equity and inclusion: In 2021, we launched our Diversity in Wine Scholarship, with the aim of helping to increase diversity and inclusivity in the wine industry. The annual programme offers candidates from Black, Asian, Minority Ethnic or other diverse backgrounds the opportunity to complete their Wine and Spirit Education Trust (WSET) Level 2 qualification free of charge, with no obligation to take up a role with Majestic upon completion of the course. Since its inception, more than 50 scholars have successfully graduated from the Diversity in Wine Scholarship, with many going on to start new careers in the wine industry.
